The competition calls for an engaging short film (less than 90 seconds) utilising the theme of motor sport to focus on one of the '10 Golden Rules for Safer Motoring' from the FIA's Action for Road Safety:

The films will be judged by a panel of experts including MERCEDES AMG PETRONAS Formula One Team driver Lewis Hamilton and Sky Sports F1 presenters.

The winning teams in each age category will attend the Italian Grand Prix weekend (6/7 September) to receive a **£2,000 prize** from Lewis Hamilton for their educational establishment's film or media studies unit, plus a **driving experience day at Silverstone**, the UK's premier F1 circuit.
